



Kim Guthrie Strategic Advisor and Division President iHeartMedia

Kim Guthrie currently serves as Strategic Advisor and was most recently Division President for iHeart Media, the largest audio company in the US, which reaches 9 of 10 Americans every month. Previously, she served as the first Chief Executive Officer of Cox Media Group, a multi-platform, integrated media group which included over 90 broadcast television and radio stations.

Kim was with Cox for 23 years – starting off as VP/General Manager for its New York radio stations – and went on to hold multiple positions at the company including being promoted to run Cox Radio in 2012, the 4th biggest radio group in the country. She later was named President at CoxReps, overseeing the country's biggest television rep firm and Gamut, a multi-platform advertising organization. In 2016, she was named President of all of CMG.

Under Kim's leadership, Kim's stations have won multiple honors for programming excellence and outstanding community service, including several Crystal awards, Dupont awards, Edward R. Murrow national awards, Emmy awards, Gracie awards, Marconi awards, Scripps Howard awards, and many others. In addition, The Atlanta Journal-Constitution newspaper was a Pulitzer Prize finalist for its "Doctors and Sex Abuse" work, while under Guthrie's supervision.

She is a multi-year honoree as Radio Ink magazine's "Most Powerful People in Radio" and "Most Influential Women in Radio." She also was named "Woman of Distinction" by the March of Dimes, "Humanitarian of the Year" by the Muscular Dystrophy Association, the "Trailblazer Award" by the Mentoring and Inspiring Women in Radio group (MIW) and was awarded the "Women Who Lead" honor by the Alliance for Women in Media (AWM).

Kim has been described as an authentic, forward-thinking leader who leads her teams through inclusive and transparent communication, courageous decision-making and an ability to build and motivate high-performance teams. She is a hands-on operator with a fun and candid leadership style.

Kim began her career as a television news reporter and TV news anchor and she holds a degree in journalism from Iowa State University. She and her husband Todd have 3 daughters who are all in the media business. Kim and Todd have 3 grandchildren and live in Connecticut.
